## **AN ACT**

To repeal sections 193.185 and 451.080, RSMo 2000, relating to marriage licenses, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to the same subject.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

- Section A. Sections 193.185 and 451.080, RSMo 2000, are repealed and two new 2 sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 193.185 and 451.080, to read as follows:
  - 193.185. 1. A report of each marriage performed in this state shall be filed with the department and shall be registered if it has been completed and filed in accordance with this section.
- 2. The official who issues the marriage license shall prepare the report on the form prescribed and furnished by the state registrar upon the basis of information obtained from one of the parties to be married.
- 3. Each person who performs a marriage shall certify the fact of marriage and return the license to the official who issued the license within [ten] sixty days after the ceremony. This license shall be signed by the witnesses to the ceremony. A marriage certificate shall be given to the parties.
- 4. Every official issuing marriage licenses shall complete and forward to the department on or before the fifteenth day of each calendar month the reports of marriages returned to such official during the preceding calendar month.
  - 451.080. 1. The recorders of the several counties of this state, and the recorder of the city of St. Louis, shall, when applied to by any person legally entitled to a marriage license, issue
