AN ACT

To repeal section 56.066, RSMo 2000, relating to prosecutors' pay, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the same subject.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 56.066, RSMo 2000, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 56.066, to read as follows:

56.066. 1. In any county which contains facilities which are operated by the department of corrections with a total average yearly inmate population in excess of seven hundred and fifty 3 persons but less than one thousand five hundred persons, the prosecuting attorney shall receive ten thousand dollars per annum in addition to all other compensation provided by law. In any county which contains facilities which are operated by the department of corrections with a total average yearly inmate population in excess of one thousand five hundred persons but less than three thousand persons, the prosecuting attorney shall receive twelve thousand five hundred dollars per annum in addition to all other compensation provided by law. In any county which contains facilities which are operated by the department of corrections with a total average yearly inmate population in excess of three thousand persons but less than four thousand persons, the 10 prosecuting attorney shall receive fifteen thousand dollars per annum in addition to all other 11 compensation provided by law. In any county which contains facilities which are operated by 12 the department of corrections with a total average inmate population in excess of four thousand 14 persons, the prosecuting attorney shall receive twenty thousand dollars per annum in addition to all other compensation provided by law. The compensation provided in connection with the 16 average inmate population shall not be considered for purposes of determining any increase in 17 compensation from January 1, 1988. The amounts provided in this subsection shall be included in the computation of the maximum allowable compensation as that term is used in section 18

- 20 **2. Subject to annual appropriation, the department of corrections shall reimburse**
- 21 the counties for the amount of the additional compensation. The reimbursement amounts
- 22 shall be limited to the amounts stated in subsection 1 of this section and shall not include
- 23 employer-paid fringe benefits. On or before the thirty-first day of January of each year,
- 24 the department shall require documentation of payment from the counties of the additional
- 25 compensation paid in the previous calendar year.
