AN ACT

To repeal section 162.291, RSMo 2000, relating to qualifications for school board members, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the same subject.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 162.291, RSMo 2000, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 162.291, to read as follows:

162.291. The voters of each seven-director district other than urban districts shall, at municipal elections, elect two directors who are citizens of the United States and resident taxpayers of the district, who have resided in [this state] **such district** for one year next preceding their election or appointment, and who are at least twenty-four years of age.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
