## AN ACT

To repeal section 217.560, RSMo 2000, relating to vocational enterprises, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the same subject.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 217.560, RSMo 2000, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 217.560, to read as follows:

217.560. The vocational enterprises program shall be diversified both as to location and kind and shall have for its purposes:

(1) The training and employment of offenders in such job skills and tasks as will afford them the most favorable opportunities practicable for gainful employment upon discharge from the department;

(2) The manufacture or provision, so far as practicable, of such goods or services as are, or may be, needed and used by a department, agency, or institution of the state or any political subdivision of the state, any state employee, **any retired state employee**, or any not-for-profit public or private agency;

(3) The servicing, maintenance, and repair, so far as practicable, of machinery and equipment used by any department, agency or institution of the state or any political subdivision thereof.
