AN ACT

To amend chapter 227, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the creation of a "Sergeant Robert Kimberling Memorial Highway".

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 227, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 227.318, to read as follows:

**227.318. The portion of interstate highway 29 in Buchanan County bounded on the
2 south by Frederick Boulevard and on the north by United States highway 169 north shall
3 be designated the "Sergeant Robert Kimberling Memorial Highway", and two signs
4 bearing this name shall be erected. One sign shall be placed north of the Frederick
5 Boulevard interchange adjacent to the northbound lane of interstate highway 29, and the
6 other shall be placed north of the United States highway 169 north overpass adjacent to
7 the southbound lane.**
