### AN ACT

To repeal section 3.130, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to statutory revision, with an effective date.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 3.130, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof,  
2 to be known as section 3.130, to read as follows:

3.130. 1. Such number of copies, **in both a bound version and an electronic version**,  
2 of each volume of each edition of the revised statutes of Missouri and annotations thereto and  
3 such number of the supplements or pocket parts thereto as may be necessary to meet the demand  
4 as determined by the committee shall be printed, bound and delivered to the revisor of statutes,  
5 who shall execute and file a receipt therefor with the director of revenue. The revisor of statutes  
6 shall distribute the copies, **in either version or combination**, without charge as follows:

7 (1) To each state department, and each division and bureau thereof, one copy **as**  
8 **requested in writing specifying the version;**

9 (2) To each member of the general assembly when first elected, [three copies] **one**  
10 **bound version and, if requested, one copy in the electronic version;** and at each general  
11 assembly thereafter, [three copies] **one copy in either version** if so requested in writing; each  
12 member to receive [three copies] **one copy of either version** of each supplement and of each  
13 new edition of the revised statutes when published;

14 (3) To each judge of the supreme court, the court of appeals and to each judge of the  
15 circuit courts, except municipal judges, one copy **in either version;**

**EXPLANATION —** Matter enclosed in bold faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law. Matter in boldface type in the above law is new proposed language.

16 (4) To the probate divisions of the circuit courts of Jackson County, St. Louis County  
17 and the city of St. Louis, four additional copies each **in either version or combination**, and to  
18 the probate divisions of the circuit courts of those counties where the judge of the probate  
19 division sits in more than one city, one additional copy each **in either version**;

20 (5) To the law library of the supreme court, ten copies **in either version or**  
21 **combination**;

22 (6) To the law libraries of each district of the court of appeals, six copies each **in either**  
23 **version or combination**;

24 (7) To the library of the United States Supreme Court, one copy **in either version**;

25 (8) To the United States district courts and circuit court of appeals for Missouri, two  
26 copies each **in either version or combination**;

27 (9) To the state historical society, two copies **in either version or combination**;

28 (10) To the libraries of the state university at Columbia, at St. Louis, at Kansas City and  
29 at Rolla, [three copies] **one bound version and one electronic version** each;

30 (11) To the state colleges, Lincoln University, the [junior] **community** colleges,  
31 Missouri Western College, **Linn State Technical College**, and Missouri Southern College, [four  
32 copies] **one bound version and one electronic version** each;

33 (12) To the public school library of St. Louis, two copies **in either version or**  
34 **combination**;

35 (13) To the Library of Congress, one copy **in either version**;

36 (14) To the Mercantile Library of St. Louis, [two copies] **one bound version and one**  
37 **electronic version**;

38 (15) To each public library in the state, if requested, one copy **in either version**;

39 (16) To the law libraries of St. Louis, St. Louis County, Kansas City and St. Joseph,  
40 [three copies] **one bound version and one electronic version** each;

41 (17) To the law schools of the state university, St. Louis University, and Washington  
42 University, [three copies] **one bound version and one electronic version** each;

43 (18) To the circuit clerk of each county of the state for distribution of one copy **in either**  
44 **version** to each county officer, to be by him **or her** delivered to his **or her** successor in office,  
45 one copy **in either version as requested in writing**;

46 (19) To the director of the committee on legislative research, such number of copies **in**  
47 **either version or combination** as may be required by such committee for the performance of  
48 its duties;

49 (20) To any county law library, when requested by the circuit clerk, [two copies] **one**  
50 **bound version and one electronic version**;

51 (21) To each county library, one copy **of either version**, when requested **in writing**;

52           (22) To any committee of the senate or house of representatives, as designated and  
53 requested by the accounts committee of the respective house.

54           2. The revisor of statutes shall also provide the librarians of the supreme court library,  
55 of the committee on legislative research, of the law schools of the state university such copies  
56 **in either version or combination** as may be necessary, not exceeding fifty-one each, to enable  
57 them to exchange the copies for like compilations or revisions of the statute laws of other states  
58 and territories.

Section B. Section A of this act shall become effective January 1, 2004.
