	Whereas, the Missouri Department of Agriculture has expressed a strong need for
2	a biosafety level 3 lab to be housed on the veterinary school campus at the University of
3	Missouri-Columbia;
4	
5	Whereas, a biosafety level 3 lab would bridge gaps within the University and the
6	University and the Department of Agriculture, the Department of Conservation, and the
7	Department of Health and Senior Services in protecting the environment from agents that are a
8	potential threat to plants and animals, but not to humans; and
9	
10	Whereas, the Missouri Farm Bureau, the Missouri Veterinary Medical Association
11	the Governor's Chronic Wasting Disease Task Force, and the Missouri Livestock and Poultry
12	Health Council have all expressed support of the establishment of a biosafety level 3 lab in the
13	State of Missouri; and
14	
15	Whereas, the establishment of a biosafety level 3 lab is of critical importance to
16	the Department of Conservation because of the threat chronic wasting disease poses for Missour
17	deer and elk herds. Since there currently is no biosafety level 3 lab in the state, the 6,000
18	samples taken during the most recent deer season in Missouri are being sent to other laboratories
19	across the country, which will most likely result in delays of several months in receiving tes-
20	results; and

22	Whereas the establishment of a biosafety level 3 lab in the State of Missouri wil
