

HB 697 -- Sex Offender Registration

Co-Sponsors: Mayer, Jolly, Pratt, Merideth, Bringer, Hubbard, Cooper (120), Bruns

Current law requires the county sheriff to forward the county's sex offender registration list to the law enforcement agencies of any city, town, or village in the county. This bill requires the list to be forwarded to the law enforcement agency for any college or university located within the county.

The bill also requires sex offenders to include in their registration information whether they are enrolled in a college and to update their registration information within seven days of changing their enrollment or employment with a college within the state.
