### AN ACT

To repeal section 417.240, RSMo, relating to registration of farm names.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 417.240, RSMo, is repealed:

2           [417.240. Any farm owner in this state may, upon the payment of one dollar  
3           to the clerk of the county commission in the county in which said farm owner may  
4           reside, have the name of his farm duly recorded in a register which the county clerk  
5           shall keep for said purpose, and shall be furnished a certificate, issued under seal, and  
6           setting forth the name and location of the farm and the name of the owner; provided,  
7           that when any name shall have been recorded as the name of any farm, such name  
8           shall not be recorded as the name of any other farm in the same county, except by  
          prefixing or adding designating words thereto.]

**EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law. Matter in boldface type in the above law is proposed language.**
