

# House Concurrent Resolution No. 24

### AN ACT

Relating to the designation of February sixth of each year as "Ronald Reagan Day" in Missouri.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

**Whereas**, President Ronald Reagan, a man of humble background, worked  
2 throughout his life serving freedom and advancing the public good, having been employed as an  
3 entertainer, union leader, corporate spokesman, Governor of California, and President of the  
4 United States; and

6 **Whereas**, Ronald Reagan served with honor and distinction for two terms as the  
7 40th President of the United States of America, the second of which he earned the confidence  
8 of three-fifths of the electorate and was victorious in 40 of the 50 states in the general election -  
9 a record unsurpassed in the history of American presidential elections; and

11 **Whereas**, during Mr. Reagan's presidency, he worked in a bipartisan manner to  
12 enact his bold agenda of restoring accountability and common sense to Government which led  
13 to an unprecedented economic expansion and opportunity for millions of Americans; and

15 **Whereas**, Mr. Reagan's commitment to an active social policy agenda for the  
16 nation's children helped lower crime and drug use in our neighborhoods; and

18 **Whereas**, President Reagan's commitment to our armed forces contributed to the

19 restoration of pride in America, her values and those cherished by the free world, and prepared  
20 America's Armed Forces to meet 21st Century challenges; and

22 **Whereas**, President Reagan's vision of "peace through strength" led to the end of  
23 the Cold War and the ultimate demise of the Soviet Union, guaranteeing basic human rights for  
24 millions of people; and

26 **Whereas**, on February 6, 2004, Ronald Reagan reached the age of ninety-three  
27 years:

28 **Now, therefore, be it resolved** that the members of the House of  
29 Representatives of the Ninety-second General Assembly, Second Regular Session, the Senate  
30 concurring therein, hereby designate February sixth of each year as "Ronald Reagan Day" in  
31 Missouri.

33 **Be it further resolved** that this resolution be sent to the Governor for his  
34 approval or rejection pursuant to the Missouri Constitution.
