AN ACT

To repeal section 21.190, RSMo, relating to legislative committees.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 21.190, RSMo, is repealed.

2 [21.190. No committee of either or of both branches of the general assembly
3 of the state of Missouri shall visit any state institution as a committee, without a
4 resolution authorizing it so to do.]
