#### **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials of the Office of Secretary of State assume no fiscal impact to their office.

Officials of the **Department of Revenue** assume there would be fiscal impact to the Highway Fund. Officials stated the Department would be required to verify that an applicant is a U.S. Citizen prior to allowing such applicant to register to vote. Verification documents must be copied by the department employee's processing the transactions and sent to the Secretary of State's Office. Officials stated their department would be required to change the testing for the over the counter driver license issuance system. Additionally, changes and testing would be required for the systems that support Central Driver License Information System (CDIS), and the Missouri Taxation and Accounting System (MTAS).

Officials estimate that there would be costs in FY 05, related to programming costs, with an estimated cost of \$4,000, and with testing costs of \$7,360. Total estimated cost to the Highway Fund would be \$11,360 in FY 05.

### <u>ASSUMPTION</u> (continued)

Officials of the **St. Louis County Board of Election Commission** stated that over the past 4 years St. Louis County posted 173,707 new registrations. This proposal would necessitate the Commission checking the registration of the applicant's verifier. From a cost standpoint, at the current rate of 1 and ½ cents for a single database query, this would add an additional \$2,600 in charges from our data services provider. Officials assume a far more significant cost though would be the new storage and filing system to replace the one presently in use to organize the standard 5" x 8" voter registration cards. St. Louis County would need a larger format card that would hold the verifier's name, address, and 4-digit number. Officials did not estimate the additional costs, however, they closed by stating that they would have to make significant administrative and procedural changes. **Oversight will show costs to St. Louis County as \$2,600 to Unknown.** 

Officials of the Kansas City Board of Election Commission stated they would have some costs. Officials stated they would have costs of printing new forms, additional training of registrars, and additional administrative impact. Officials did not estimate fiscal impact. Oversight will show fiscal impact to Kansas City Board of Election Commission as negative Unknown.

Officials of the **Jasper County Commission** assume there would be minimal costs related to printing startup forms.

Oversight will show fiscal impact to local government, for additional duties, and other costs as (\$2,600 to a negative Unknown). Fiscal impact on a statewide basis is indeterminable.
