FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

Currently after a watershed subdistrict has been organized and the organization tax has been levied, any county in the subdistrict not adopting the annual tax may detach from the subdistrict upon majority approval of the qualified voters residing within the subdistrict in the county. This bill changes the county detachment requirement to a majority approval of the voters voting on the detachment within the subdistrict in the county.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
