#### **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

## **ASSUMPTION**

Officials of the **Department of Economic Development - Division of Tourism** assume no fiscal impact.

Officials of the **City of Pacific** stated this proposal would enable the City to promote tourism. Officials estimate in FY 2005 the guest tax at a 3% rate with an estimated 1/4 % capacity (year-round average), would generate approximately \$18,765. Income in FY 2006 is estimated to be \$19,140 and \$19,714 in FY 2007.

**Oversight** assumes the guest tax is permissive and would require voter approval before the tax could be imposed.

## FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

If the City of Pacific were to receive voter approval to impose a transient guest tax, small businesses located in the City and are in the hotel, or motel industry would be expected to collect and administer the tax.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

This bill authorizes, upon voter approval, a transit guest tax of not more than 5% on all sleeping rooms of hotels or motels in the City of Pacific.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
