FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials with the **Department of Public Safety – Missouri Veterans Commission** assume this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials with the **Department of Transportation (MoDOT)** assume the Submarine Veterans' Association will pay for all the appropriate signage for the "Submarine Veterans' Highway," and that the Laura Ingalls Wilder Museum will pay for all the appropriate signage for the "Laura Ingalls Wilder Memorial Highway." MoDOT indicated that no private funds are in place for the "Brown-Stinson Memorial Bridge." Such signs would cost \$606.

Oversight assumes that signs will not be erected until private funding is in place and funds are received.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

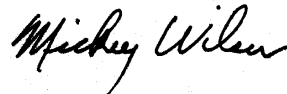
DESCRIPTION

This legislation designates a portion of Interstate 70 in Saline, Cooper, and Benton counties as the "Submarine Veterans' Highway," a portion of State Highway A in Wright County as the "Laura Ingalls Wilder Memorial Highway," and a bridge on State Route 30 in Franklin County as the "Brown-Stinson Memorial Bridge."

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
