### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

### **DESCRIPTION**

This act designates a portion of U.S. Highway 60 one mile east of U.S. Highway 65 to the U.S. Highway 60 and U.S. Highway 65 intersection as the Trooper Russell Harper Memorial Highway." Costs for such designation will be paid by the Missouri Troopers' Association.
