FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials with the **Department of Transportation (MoDOT)** assume that the Missouri Troopers' Association will pay for signs designating the "Trooper Russell Harper Memorial Highway" and the "Trooper Dennis H. Marriott Memorial Highway," as is stipulated. MoDOT indicated that no private funds are in place for signage for either the "Trooper Wayne W. Allman Memorial Bridge" or the "Brown-Stinson Memorial Bridge." Such signs would cost \$753 and \$606, respectively. **Oversight** assumes that signs will not be erected until private funding is in place.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This act designates a portion of U.S. Highway 60 in Greene County as the Trooper Russell Harper Memorial Highway" and a portion of U.S. Highway 54 in Cole County as the "Trooper Dennis H. Marriott Memorial Highway." Costs for such designations will be paid by the Missouri Troopers' Association. This act also designates a bridge on State Route 7 in Cass County as the "Trooper Wayne W. Allman Memorial Bridge" and a bridge on State Route 30 in Franklin County as the "Brown-Stinson Memorial Bridge."

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
