#### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

### **DESCRIPTION**

The proposed legislation would allow alimony and maintenance to be terminated based on the former spouse cohabiting with another person in a romantic nature. The proposal would also repeal the statutory authority for associate circuit judges to hear chapter 452 cases.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
