FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

Under current law, a \$2 surcharge is collected in certain criminal cases to be used to develop biometric identification systems for identifying and tracking inmates within local jail systems. The proposed legislation would allow the funds to also be used for any expenses related to housing prisoners.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
