FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This bill extends the immunity from civil liability currently granted to landowners adjoining the Katy Trail State Park and certain municipal and county trails to landowners adjoining all publicly owned trails dedicated for recreation. The bill, however, removes from the immunity any situation where injuries are caused by the failure of the occupant of the land to warn of an artificial condition created or maintained by the occupant that is likely to cause death or serious injury.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
