FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of Administration (COA) - Division of Accounting, COA - Division of Budget and Planning** and **Missouri House of Representatives** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Officials from the **Department of Insurance** state the cost of the membership dues in the National Conference of Insurance Legislators are approximately \$10,000 annually. These costs will be paid from the Insurance Dedicated Fund.

Officials from the **Missouri Senate (SEN)** state this proposal would assign statutory authority for paying the State of Missouri's annual dues for membership in the National Conference of Insurance Legislators to the Department of Insurance. In doing so, this proposal would also appear to be statutorily mandating membership in the organization.

Until calendar year 2003, the legislature has typically paid for the membership to this organization out of the joint contingent appropriation (General Revenue). Annual dues are presently \$10,000 per year. Dues for calendar year 2003 remain unpaid (due to budget cuts) and the dues for calendar year 2004 have already been invoiced by the organization.
