### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

### **DESCRIPTION**

This legislation renames a portion of U.S. Highway 60, also known as the James River Freeway, from its intersection with U.S. Highway 65, west to its connection with state route 360, following northwest to its intersection with interstate highway 44 as the "Korean War Veterans' Freeway." The previous name was the "Korean Veterans' Memorial Freeway."

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
