FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal requires organ procurement organizations in Missouri which receive an anatomical gift of a vascular organ to use its best efforts to determine if there is a suitable recipient on a transplant list in Missouri. The vascular organ must be suitable for transplantation, and the donor is prohibited from naming a specific recipient.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
