FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of the Attorney General** assume the cost of the proposed legislation could be absorbed within existing resources.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** assume the proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on the courts.

Officials from the **Office of Secretary of State (SOS)** assume the Attorney General's Office may rescind, amend, or promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this act. These rules would be published in the Missouri Register and the Code of State Regulations. These rules could require as many as 6 pages in the Code of State Regulations and half again as many pages in the Missouri Register, as cost statements, fiscal notes, and the like are not repeated in the Code. The estimated cost of a page in the Missouri Register is \$23 and the estimated cost of a page in the Code of State Regulations is \$27. Based on these costs, the estimated cost of the proposal is \$369 in FY 05 and unknown in subsequent years. The actual cost could be more or less than the numbers given. The impact of this legislation in future years is unknown and depends upon the frequency and length of rules filed, amended, rescinded, or withdrawn.

<u>ASSUMPTION</u> (continued)

Oversight assumes the SOS could absorb the costs of printing and distributing regulations related to this proposal. If multiple bills pass which would require the printing and distribution of regulations at substantial costs, the SOS could request funding through the appropriation process.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation would expand the database of telephone numbers maintained by the Attorney General known as the No-Call List to include business subscribers and cell phone numbers of both business and residential subscribers who ask that their numbers be placed on the list. Currently, only residential subscribers who have telephone service provided by a local exchange company are included.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
