FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This bill makes the use of a cellular phone or other wireless device to transmit ballot contents to unauthorized persons a class three election offense and makes a voter's use of a cellular phone or other wireless device in the polling place to give or receive voting information a class four election offense.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.


