ASSUMPTION

Officials of the **House of Representatives** and the **Senate** stated that the proposal should not have any fiscal or administrative effect on their agencies.

Officials of the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Veterans Commission** stated that they could not estimate the fiscal impact of this proposal until they had a chance to consider outreach proposals. They did not request additional resources at this time.

Oversight notes new Commission-approved outreach programs might cause requests for additional funds. Personnel service appropriations for the Commission have come from the Missouri Veterans' Home Fund, the Veterans' Trust Fund and the General Revenue Fund.
