ASSUMPTION

Officials with the **Department of Transportation** (MoDOT) indicated that no private sources have as of yet agreed to pay for all the appropriate signage; therefore, MoDOT assumes a possible fiscal impact to the Road Fund of \$754. **Oversight** assumes that signage would not be erected unless and until private funding was in place.
