DESCRIPTION

This proposal prohibits courts from awarding custody, visitation, or unsupervised visitation to a parent if the parent or anyone residing with the parent has committed a sex offense against any child. Current law prohibits courts from awarding custody or visitation to a parent who has committed a sex offense against the child who is the subject of the order.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
