# **ASSUMPTION**

Officials with the **Department of Public Safety** assume this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials with the **Department of Transportation (MoDOT)** assume that private donations will be solicited to pay for appropriate signage in accordance with this act. MoDOT assumes the costs of the appropriate signs to total \$754. If the donations do not cover the cost of the signs, MoDOT assumes that the additional amounts would be paid for out of the Road Fund. **Oversight** assumes that MoDOT would not purchase or install such signs until private funding is in place.

## FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

This act designates a portion of U.S. Highway 67 in St. Francois County between Desloge and Bonne Terre as the "Trooper Jesse R. Jenkins Memorial Highway." Costs for such designation will be paid by private donations.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
