#### **DESCRIPTION**

This proposal revises the laws regarding the Missouri Basic Property Insurance Inspection and Placement Program. The proposal increases from \$100,000 to \$200,000 the maximum limit of liability on a residential property in the program.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
