### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

Small businesses would be expected to remit the increased business license fee as a result of this proposal.

#### DESCRIPTION

Under current law, a business license tax up to \$10,000 may be imposed by villages with less than 1,300 inhabitants. This proposal increases that limit to \$20,000.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
