No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation would revise laws pertaining to accident reports and their disclosure. The proposal would specify that investigative reports could be computer-generated. Current law specifies that investigative reports be written.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
