FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation would clarify that the required procedure for the processing of accident reports by law enforcement officers would include computer-generated reports, in addition to written reports.

The proposal would also repeal the provision that prohibits law enforcement officers from releasing accident reports to anyone who is not an interested party until 60 days after the accident.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
