AN ACT

Relating to requirements for persons administering injections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

- Section 1. 1. No drug or medication shall be administered to any patient or individual by injection for a fee unless it is administered by a person currently licensed by the state board of registration for the healing arts whose scope of practice includes the administration of drugs or medication by injection.
 - 2. Nothing in this section shall be construed as prohibiting:
 - (1) The self-administration of drugs or medications by injection; or
 - (2) The administration of drugs or medications by injection in the patient's or individual's home by a family member, friend, or other person not licensed by the state board of registration for the healing arts with the consent of such patient or individual and
- 10 if such family member, friend, or person does not receive any monetary remuneration.
