## **AN ACT**

To repeal section 174.453, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to qualifications for the board of governors of Missouri Southern State University - Joplin.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 174.453, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 174.453, to read as follows:

174.453. 1. The board of governors shall be appointed as follows:

- 2 (1) Five voting members shall be selected from the counties comprising the institution's 3 historic statutory service region as described in section 174.010, except that no more than two 4 members shall be appointed from any one county with a population of less than two hundred
- 5 thousand inhabitants;

- (2) Two voting members shall be selected from any of the counties in the state which are outside of the institution's historic service region; and
- 8 (3) One nonvoting member who is a student shall be selected in the same manner as 9 prescribed in section 174.055.
- 10 2. The term of service of the governors shall be as follows:
- 11 (1) The voting members shall be appointed for terms of six years; and
- 12 (2) The nonvoting student member shall serve a two-year term.
- 3. Members of any board of governors selected pursuant to this section and in office on May 13, 1999, shall serve the remainder of their unexpired terms.
- 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1 of this section, the board of governors of Missouri Southern State University Joplin shall be appointed as follows:
- 17 (1) Five voting members shall be selected from any of the following counties: 18 Barton, Jasper, Newton, McDonald, Dade, Lawrence, and Barry provided that no more

- 19 than three of these five members shall be appointed from any one county;
- 20 (2) Two voting members shall be selected from any of the counties in the state which are outside of the counties articulated in subdivision (1) of this subsection;
- 22 (3) One nonvoting member who is a student shall be selected in the same manner 23 as prescribed in section 174.055; and
- 24 (4) The provisions of subdivisions (1) and (2) of this subsection shall only apply to 25 board members first appointed after August 28, 2004.
