AN ACT

To repeal section 9.040, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to Missouri Day.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 9.040, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof,
2 to be known as section 9.040, to read as follows:

9.040. The [third Wednesday of October] **eighth day of May** of each year is known and
2 designated as "Missouri Day" and is set apart as a day commemorative of Missouri history to be
3 observed by the teachers and pupils of schools with the appropriate exercises. The people of the
4 state of Missouri, and the educational, commercial, political, civic, religious and fraternal
5 organizations of the state of Missouri are requested to devote some part of the day to the
6 methodical consideration of the products of the mines, fields, and forests of the state and to the
7 consideration of the achievements of the sons and daughters of Missouri in commerce, literature,
8 statesmanship, science and art, and in other departments of activity in which the state has
9 rendered service to mankind.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law. Matter in boldface type in the above law is proposed language.
