AN ACT

To amend chapter 304, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to unauthorized use of traffic signal preemption systems, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 304, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 304.077, to read as follows:

304.077. 1. As used in this section "traffic signal preemption system (TSPS)" 2 means a traffic control system designated for use by emergency vehicles, as defined in 3 section 304.020, to improve traffic movement by temporarily controlling signalized 4 intersections.

5 **2.** The owner of a traffic control signal may authorize use of a TSPS by the 6 following persons for the following purposes:

7 (1) An authorized operator in an authorized emergency vehicle, in order to improve
8 the safety and efficiency of emergency response operations;

9 (2) An authorized operator in a bus, in order to interrupt the cycle of the traffic 10 control signal in such a way as to keep the green light showing for longer than it otherwise 11 would;

12 (3) An authorized operator in a traffic signal maintenance vehicle, in order to 13 facilitate traffic signal maintenance activities.

3. A TSPS used by an authorized person in an emergency vehicle shall preempt and
 override a device operated by any other person.

4. A traffic control signal operating device used as authorized under this section
 must operate in such a way that the device does not continue to control the signal once the

- 18 vehicle containing the device has arrived at the intersection, regardless of whether the
- 19 vehicle remains at the intersection.
- 20 5. It shall be unlawful for any person not approved herein to use a TSPS to control
- 21 traffic.
- 22 6. Violation of the provisions of this section is a class B misdemeanor.
