AN ACT

To amend chapter 105, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to lobbying.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 105, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 105.479, to read as follows:

105.479. 1. No person shall perform the functions of an executive lobbyist, judicial lobbyist, or legislative lobbyist, as those terms are defined in section 105.470, within twelve months of leaving a position as a statewide elected official or member of the general assembly.

5 2. Any person who knowingly violates this section shall be guilty of illegal lobbying, 6 and shall be subject to a civil penalty in an amount not to exceed ten thousand dollars for 7 each violation. Such civil penalties shall be collected by action filed by the Missouri ethics 8 commission. Any resident of the state or member of the commission may file a civil 9 complaint against any person violating this section.
