## House Concurrent Resolution No. 20

## 92<sup>ND</sup> GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

	Whereas, the Government Pension Offset (GPO) and Windfall Elimination
2 3 4	Provision (WEP) of the federal Social Security Act penalize people who have dedicated their lives to public service by taking away benefits they have earned; and
5	Whereas, nine out of ten public employees affected by the GPO lose their entire
6 7	spousal benefit, even though their spouse paid Social Security taxes for many years; and
8	Whereas, the WEP causes hard-working people to lose up to sixty percent of the
9 10	benefits they earned themselves; and
11	Whereas, many workers rely on misleading Social Security Administration
12 13	statements that fail to take into account the GPO and WEP when projecting benefits; and
14	Whereas, the impact of the GPO and WEP is not just felt in those states in which
15 16 17	public employees, including educators, are not covered by Social Security, because people move from state to state and affected individuals are everywhere; and
18	Whereas, the GPO and WEP apply to all vested members of the Public School
19 20	Retirement System of Missouri; and

21	Whereas, the number of people affected across the country is growing every day
22 23	as more and more people reach retirement age; and
24	Whereas, some 300,000 individuals lose an average of \$3,600 a year due to the
25 26	GPO which can make the difference between self-sufficiency and poverty; and
27	Whereas, these people have less money to spend in their local economy and
28 29 30	sometimes have to turn to expensive government programs like food stamps to make ends meet; and
31	Whereas, during a national teacher shortage, the GPO and WEP discourage people
32 33 34	from entering and staying in the teaching profession, since doing so will mean a loss of earned Social Security benefits; and
35	Whereas, the GPO and WEP are also causing current educators to leave the
36 37	profession and students to choose courses of study other than education; and
38	Whereas, non-Social Security states are finding it increasingly difficult to attract
39 40	quality educators as more people learn about the GPO and WEP; and
41 42	Whereas, the nation should respect, not penalize, public service; and
43	Whereas, the GPO and WEP are established in federal law and repeal of the GPO
44 45	and WEP can only be enacted by the United States Congress:
46	Now, therefore, be it resolved that the members of the House of
47	Representatives of the Ninety-second General Assembly, Second Regular Session, the Senate

48 concurring therein, hereby urge the Congress of the United States to immediately repeal the

49 Government Pension Offset and Windfall Elimination Provision of the Social Security Act; and
