Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

	Whereas, the United States is just beginning to recover from a depressed economy;

4	Whereas, most states are experiencing a job gap between actual jobs available and
5	the number of jobs needed to keep up with the growth in working age population; and

7	Whereas, Missouri revenues have been adversely affected by the economy; and

9	Whereas, state revenues will recover at a slower pace than the economy at large;

12	Whereas, federal tax cuts will result in lower Missouri revenue due to coupling;

15	Whereas, Missouri struggles with the challenges of a significant budget deficit;

18	Whereas, the federal government has funds available for two trillion dollars in tax
19	cuts that disproportionately benefit the most prosperous Americans; and

Whereas, federal unfunded mandates in IDEA, No Child Left Behind, Election 21 22 Reform, and Homeland Security cost the states more than twenty billion dollars per year: 23 Now, therefore, be it resolved that the members of the House of 24 25 Representatives of the Ninety-second General Assembly, Second Regular Session, the Senate concurring therein, hereby urge the United States Congress to pass a fiscal relief package for the 26 27 states of no less than twenty billion dollars; and 28 Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of 29 Representatives be instructed to prepare properly inscribed copies of this resolution for each 30 member of the Missouri Congressional Delegation. 31
