## AN ACT

To amend chapter 226, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to highways.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 226, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 226.006, to read as follows:

3 **226.006. The department of transportation shall create an oversight advisory**  
4 **committee composed of not less than ten members to examine the traffic congestion**  
5 **problems which occur at the intersections of Fifty-Second Street and U.S. Highway 71,**  
6 **Fifty-Fifth Street and U.S. Highway 71, and Seventy-Fifth Street and U.S. Highway 71.**  
7 **The department, in consultation with the commission, shall conduct a feasibility study to**  
8 **determine whether overpass systems should be established at such intersections and shall**  
9 **also explore other avenues which would help alleviate congestion at those intersections.**  
10 **The department of transportation shall summarize its findings and report them to the**  
11 **general assembly no later than December 1, 2005.**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
