AN ACT

To repeal section 301.700, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to all-terrain vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 301.700, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu
2 thereof, to be known as section 301.700, to read as follows:

301.700. **Notwithstanding the provisions of section 144.010, RSMo, and any other**
2 **law, new and used** all-terrain vehicles **purchased from dealers or private individuals** shall
3 be treated in the same manner as motor vehicles, pursuant to this chapter, for the purposes of
4 transfer, titling, perfection of liens and encumbrances, and the collection of all taxes, fees and
5 other charges, **regardless of the purchase price**. Funds collected by the department of revenue
6 pursuant to sections 301.700 to 301.714 shall be deposited by the director in the state treasury
7 to the credit of the general revenue fund.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
