### AN ACT

To amend chapter 9, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the designation of Ronald Reagan Day in Missouri.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 9, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 9.165, to read as follows:

2 **9.165. The governor annually shall issue a proclamation setting apart February**  
3 **sixth as "Ronald Reagan Day" in Missouri. The governor's proclamation shall recommend**  
4 **that the day be observed by the people with appropriate exercises in the public schools and**  
5 **otherwise to the end that the memory of the public service and the humanitarian principles**  
of Ronald Reagan may be perpetuated.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
