### AN ACT

To repeal section 86.337, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to police relief and pension systems.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 86.337, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu  
2 thereof, to be known as section 86.337, to read as follows:

86.337. The total amount payable to the retirement system for each fiscal year shall be  
2 not less than the **greater of (1) the** normal contribution rate of the total compensation earnable  
3 by all members during the year[; provided, however, that the aggregate payment by the said cities  
4 shall be sufficient] **and (2) the amount which**, when combined with the assets of the retirement  
5 system, **is sufficient** to provide the pensions and other benefits payable during the then current  
6 year.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
