### AN ACT

To amend chapter 66, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to Jackson county official term limits.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 66, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 66.403, to read as follows:

3 **66.403. No person shall be elected to serve more than eight years total as the county**  
4 **executive or in the legislature of any county with a charter form of government and with**  
5 **more than six hundred thousand but fewer than seven hundred thousand inhabitants. In**  
6 **applying this section, service as such county executive or in such legislature resulting from**  
7 **an election prior to August 28, 2005, or service of less than two years, in the case of a**  
8 **member or county executive elected after the effective date of this section to complete the**  
9 **term of another person, shall not be counted.**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
