Read 2nd time February 7, 2005 and referred to the Committee on Judiciary February 17, 2005.

Reported from the Committee on Rules March 10, 2005 with recommendation that the bill Do Pass by Consent with no time limit for debate.

## AN ACT

To repeal section 540.031, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to duties of grand juries.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 540.031, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 540.031, to read as follows:

540.031. A grand jury may make inquiry into and return indictments for all grades of crimes and shall make inquiry into all possible violations of the criminal laws as the court may direct. [The grand jury shall examine public buildings and report on their conditions.]

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
