## FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

#### **DESCRIPTION**

This bill increases from \$1,500 to \$5,000 per annum the amount that city board members can accept for performing services or selling, renting, or leasing property to their city boards.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
