DESCRIPTION

This bill doubles the limit on campaign contributions made by individuals and makes those limits applicable to continuing committees which are political party committees. The bill also reduces by 90% the limit on campaign contributions made by political party committees.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
