FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal specifies that anti-kickback laws in Section 191.905, RSMo, relating to referrals for health care services do not apply to certain programs established by pharmaceutical companies for the purposes of providing a partial rebate of private health insurance copayments and coinsurance to patients with multiple sclerosis or other chronic, potentially disabling, or life-threatening conditions who have been prescribed disease-managing medicines for which there are no generic equivalents.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
