## FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

This proposal may impact small business medical offices.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

Currently, health care providers are allowed to charge a handling fee of \$15 plus a fee of 35 cents per page to copy a patient's health care record. This proposal allows health care providers to charge a reasonable cost-based fee and condition the furnishing of the records on the payment of this fee. The fee includes copying charges of \$17.05 plus 40 cents per page for the costs of supplies and labor, postage costs, and notary fees.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
